



WORLD HOMEOPATHY AWARENESS WEEK

10-16 APRIL 2017

An exciting range of activities are being planned by the numerous national homeopathic associations throughout Europe to mark the anniversary of Dr Samuel Hahnemann's birth on and around 10 April 2017.



United Kingdom

On 6 April the British homeopathic community will host the world premiere of *Just one Drop*, a documentary film about homeopathy, at a VIP, red carpet event in Central London. They will also use the Snooks to promote Homeopathy Awareness week with a new website, as well as adding a specific HAW page to the findahomeopath.org website.

Czech Republic

The Czech homeopaths are planning to hold a public lecture in Ostrava about homeopathy, aimed at lay people.

They will post a special article to their websites (HLA and www.svethomeopatie.cz, which is also targeting lay people). The whole week's activities will be shared on social media, specifically Facebook and Twitter.



Austria

A press conference will be held in Austria on 4 April of which the primary focus will be Good Manufacturing Practice, and the presentation of the newly-published book: Homeopathy – therapies with fine differences. 10 colleagues have documented acute and chronic cases which they treated in their practice. This volume is over 200 pages and targeted at anyone with an interest in homeopathy (laymen, nurses, patients, MDs etc.)

Three days on there will be lessons held for the general public in Vienna, which is expected to attract 100-200 participants.

Italy

For Homeopathy Awareness Day, SIOMI will publish an article on the online magazine *Omeopatia 33*, whilst FIAMO has plans to host a public lecture in Napoli. Moreover, some Italian manufacturers of homeopathic medicines (e.g. GUNA) are organising free homeopathic consultations on 10 April - if a homeopathic doctor offers to take part, their name will feature on the dedicated website and they will provide their time free of charge.



Bulgaria

Bulgarian homeopaths have organised lectures for general practitioners and members of their association in 4 cities – Varna, Burgas, Plovdiv and Sofia. The theme for these lectures is "Homeopathy and cardiovascular diseases".

They have also prepared 3 short films (3-4) featuring stories of patients of active age who have been treated with homeopathy. These will be professionally produced with the intention to reach a wide audience via social media.

Homeopath colleagues will participate in 2 TV health programmes on the morning of 10 April.

Later on the same day, at 6pm, they will hold "our moment to celebrate homeopathy" – Homeopaths invite patients and colleagues to express how the use of homeopathy has worked remarkably to the benefit of practitioner and patient alike.

Spain

The AMHB in Barcelona has the following plans to commemorate Hahnemann:

- Laying of memorial wreath at Hahnemann's monument in Barcelona.
- Hosting a public lecture on "Homeopathy for Beginners".
- Presentation of the new Homeopathic Patients Association: ACPAUH
- A dinner for AMHB's members.

Greece

The Homeopathic Academy will celebrate International Homeopathy Day with an educational visit for doctors, dentists, vets and pharmacists to the Homeopathic Pharmaceutical Industry "Korres" at Viotia district.

After a short meal that will include references to Hahnemann's life, the participants will visit the laboratories for a live exhibition of the potentization of a homeopathic remedy.

A press release, e-posts and interviews will be published following the event.



France

Three French homeopathic associations (SNMHF, SSH and the patients' association AHP-F) have drafted a joint press release to be distributed to mainstream and medical media for this occasion. It is intended to serve as a reminder of the popularity of homeopathic treatment across the world, and also to share information on the very latest achievements such as the EN 16782 standard and the ongoing research into the efficacy and mode of action of Homeopathy.

Slovenia

The Association for Homeopathy will hold an open-table public event on 13 April.

Two public lectures will be held on 11 April at the Slovene Ethnographic Museum (<http://www.etno-muzej.si/en>). Irena Gorišek, president of the Slovenian Homeopathic Society will run a lecture Homeopathy for the Elderly and Nena Židov, PhD, curator at the Slovene Ethnographic Museum will have a lecture History of homeopathic treatment of domestic animals in Slovenia in the 19th and early 20th Century.
