Take the education and practice of homeopathy in Europe to a higher level

Vision:

- To create a common media of information for future homeopathic students.
- Cooperation of SC research – education – pharmacy - proving in order to create educational tools.

Insights:

We have a community of people who know how to study, who have sensors about the genuine knowledge and are skilled to develop our science. We do not know much about the local homeopathic teachers – their abilities, their problems.

We would like to provide help and **create communication media for sharing experience and supporting each other with ideas and know-how.**

It is not about teaching teachers how to teach.

A very important task is changing the way teachers and students present homeopathy to the world. We must inform confidently about our results in curing acute and chronic cases, to present at the highest scientific level how homeopathy works.

Target group: Who are the local teachers in the homeopathic schools?– we need a new look of that group.

Actually, the words “teacher” and “student” are misleading – the teachers and the students in the accredited European schools are doctors in human, dental and veterinary medicine, they have studied medicine for 6 years, 3-4 years more to take specialty and on top of that, they embraced classical homeopathy and study sincerely. Then they become teachers in homeopathy.

Aims we agreed about:

- To support teachers with tools for teaching - ppt, pdf, e-learning modules available for all accredited schools.
- To stimulate teachers to present at local and international medical non-homeopathic forums.
- To get feedback about different models of education, pro and cons (exchange of experiences and models of good practice)
- To motivate schools to use CEN opportunities and apply for ECH Accreditation.

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
